## Doctrinal Statement



### 1. We believe that the 66 books of the Old and New Testaments are...

- verbally inspired by God (1 Cor. 2:13),
- without error in the original writings (2 Pet. 1:21; Ps. 12:6, Matt. 5:18),
- and that they are the final authority in all matters relating to everyday life and to all truth... whether it be doctrinal, theological, historical, or scientific (2 Tim. 3:16, Ps. 19:7-11).

### 2. We believe in the triunity of the one and only true God (Deut. 4:39; Isa. 42:8; Matt. 28:19; 2 Cor. 13:14):

- **the Father** (Jn. 6:27; 1 Pet. 1:2)
- **the Son** (Jn. 3:13, 31; 8:58; Jn. 10:30),
- **the Holy Spirit** (Jn. 14:16; Jn. 16:7-11; 1 Cor. 2:11-12; Ps. 139:7).

Muslims may better understand this triunity as **God**, the **Word of God**, and the **Spirit of God** because they understand “Son” to infer that God somehow had sex and produced an offspring. We, of course, would not agree with that falsehood either.

### 3. We believe that the eternal Son became a man in the person of Jesus, the Messiah (Dan. 9:25; Phil. 2:5-11; Jn. 1:1, 14, 41)...

- He was born of the Virgin Mary, having been conceived by the Holy Spirit in order to take on a natural, physical, human form (Matt. 1:18-25).
- He is fully God and completely and perfectly human (Jn. 20:26-29; Heb. 4:15; Col. 2:9; Luke 2:52).

• He died in our place, in order to save us from the eternal consequences of our sin. This is both a personal sin and an inherited sin nature that has its origin in the disobedience of Adam and Eve (1 Pet 3:18; Rom. 3:23, 5:12; Jn. 3:16; Isaiah 53:5).

• He rose from the dead, ascended to heaven, and He will return again exactly as the Scriptures indicate (Matt. 28:6-7; Jn. 11:25; 1 Cor. 15:3-8; Acts 1:9-11).

### 4. We believe that any person who places saving faith in the Lord Jesus Christ (Eph. 2:8-9, Titus 3:5; Acts 16:31)...

- has been purchased and set free from slavery to sin (1 Cor. 6:20; Rom. 6:18),
- has been reconciled to God, and is no longer under His wrath (2 Cor. 5:18; John 3:36),
- has been declared righteous before God (Rom. 5:1; 1 Cor. 6:11),
- has passed from death to life... a true transformation (Jn. 5:24, 2 Cor. 5:17),
- has received the permanent, in-dwelling presence of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 12:13; Eph. 1:13),
- has become a member of the Body of Christ (Rom. 12:5; Col. 3:15),
- continues in a process of sanctification in this present life (1 Thes. 5:23-24; Col. 2:6-7), and will ultimately spend all eternity with God (Jn. 6:40, 10:27-28, 14:2-3; Phil. 3:20-21).

### 5. Those who reject this divine plan of redemption will spend all eternity separated from the presence of God, in a place that was originally created for the devil and those angels that followed him in rebellion against God (Matt. 25:41, 46; Rev. 20:11-15).

## The Basic Objectives of The People of the Book, Inc.

We desire to share the Good News of ‘Isa al-Masih (*Jesus the Messiah*) with the growing Muslim population in the Spanish-speaking world. We will also continue to make disciples among the non-Muslim population. The main process that we will use to accomplish this, by the grace of God, is the following:

- **Evangelize** the lost by clearly sharing the Gospel through our words and actions (Matt. 4:19, 5:16, 28:19-20), producing new believers in the Lord Jesus Christ.
- **Establish** new believers in a consistent, dynamic, personal relationship with God (Col. 2:6-7; Matt. 22:37-40; Gal. 5:22-23), in order to raise up disciples who daily read the Bible and pray, and who live in obedience to God in the context of a local community of believers.
- **Equip** those who have a close walk with the Lord so that they can:
  - effectively share their faith with others and follow-up new believers
  - instruct others in the basics of the Christian life (Eph. 4:11-12)
  - produce laborers who can carry on a disciple-making ministry.
- **Develop** mature leaders in local congregations who can, in turn, start new congregations and train up new leadership (Mark 3:14, Titus 1:5-9, 1 Tim. 3:1-13, 1 Pet. 5:1-3), who can reproduce this entire process.
- **Multiply** laborers for God’s harvest to the third and fourth spiritual generation (2 Tim. 2:1-2), so that all people everywhere can hear and understand the Good News of our Lord Jesus Christ.
